All Students are strongly recommended to start with the foundation course, it is good for orientation and to make sure their attitude towards studying and work is set for success. The course has a strong focus on entrepreneurial skills – we do this because it will give students the opportunity to earn and save money to pay for the next courses. An added advantage is that 2 most promising students of the foundation course will be offered a scholarship to join the hospitality course.

English Level Test, Computer level test and Interview

To enter the hospitality or Tourism course a computer skills certificate and a certain level of English is required (see schedule) During the application period each candidate has to participate in an English level test, computer level test and a motivation interview. (10.000)

We use CEFR Guidelines (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)

Payments/ Ada

Payment can be done prior to the training or in instalments – a few people can apply for a Microfinance loan, learn now pay later when you have a job. You can apply for a Pay it Forward loan at Kawa Training Center- this is only for students who start with a foundation course. Students can pay part of their school fees by doing jobs for Kawa and being active in Kawa Clubs

Students can build up study credit in this way. Students who have proven to be credit worthy during the foundation course will be considered for a Pay it forward loan for the hospitality course.

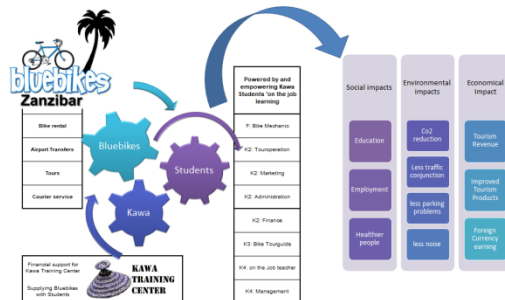
